COVID-19 INFORMATION UPDATE

- We would encourage everyone to get fully vaccinated where possible to maximise protection for everyone, however British Racing is not currently requesting proof of vaccination as a condition of entry.
- We would strongly encourage racegoers to ensure they are proven to be Covid Negative in advance of attending and would recommend taking a lateral flow test 24 hours prior to attendance and 48 hours afterwards. If you receive a positive test, please follow Government guidelines and follow this up with a PCR test. Racegoers can claim a full refund if a positive test means you have to miss the race meeting.
- We have NHS Covid-19 QR codes at all entrances and would encourage people to check in using the app as they arrive.
- Face coverings are to be worn at your discretion. For the safety of others, we would strongly encourage you to wear them in areas where you will come into contact with lots of people, particularly indoors.
- Social-distancing is no longer a requirement but we do request that you respect the personal space of others whenever possible.
- Hand sanitisation points will be available around the Racecourse, and we request that you continue to adopt good hand hygiene throughout the day.
- Our catering, bar and stewarding staff are receiving twice-weekly lateral flow tests and will be encouraged to wear face coverings in areas where they will come into close contact with lots of people, particularly indoors.
- Should a racegoer attending a meeting subsequently test positive for Covid-19, the venue will be issued with a recommendation notice to be tested. We will contact all who have pre-booked and place a notice on our website encouraging all to take a test as soon as possible. You are not required to self-isolate unless this test proves positive or unless you are contacted directly by NHS Track and Trace, who will then provide you with full guidance.
