

THE COVID PASS

The use of the COVID Pass (England and Wales) or COVID Vaccination Certificate (Scotland) to demonstrate COVID status is designed to offer an additional layer of protection to all attendees and to help prevent further restrictions such as capacity limits or closure.

In accordance with Government Covid legislation, a valid COVID Pass or negative Covid Test within the past 48 hours will be required for access to the race fixture on 26th & 27th December at Wetherby Racecourse and for our early 2022 race fixtures where we expect a crowd of in excess of 4,000+.

Please note that this applies to attendees aged 18yrs and over, and it can be a digital or paper pass.

DIGITAL PASS

If have a smartphone, you can download the NHS APP (Which is different from the NHS Covid-19 App), following a series of security procedures which includes photographic identification verification, the APP will display a QR Code and Green Tick (✓) to confirm the individual has:

- Been vaccinated with 2 doses of an approved vaccine (or one of the single-dose Janssen vaccine).
- Had a negative PCR or LFT test within the previous 48 hours.
- Are exempt from vaccination or vaccination and testing on the basis of a medical exemption or clinical trial participation.



It is recommended that you download the pass to your smartphone to avoid any issues regarding signal at the Entrance point. You can of course also download and print the pass, bringing a physical copy with you on the day.

Please ensure that the pass is Valid as they expire every 30 days. To update your pass, simply log back in to the NHS APP and it will refresh your pass.

PAPER PASS

Attendees who are over 18 and fully vaccinated, but do not have the ability to obtain a digital passport through a computer, tablet or smartphone, can request a paper NHS COVID pass. Also, anyone who do not have photographic ID must register for the paper NHS COVID pass.

This service is available seven days a week, between 9am and 5pm. To request a paper NHS COVID pass, call **119**. GPs cannot provide this service.

Please note this can take up to 7 working days to arrive, therefore anyone who must use this service is recommended to do so as soon as possible.

A NEGATIVE LATERAL FLOW TEST WITHIN 48HRS OF EVENT

All those aged 18 years and over, who are not fully vaccinated must have a recent negative Lateral Flow Test result (within the past 48 hours), in order to attend.

LFT Kits are available to order online from the Government website [HERE](#). They are also available to collect from pharmacies and there will also be a local collection point in your area.

The tests must be taken at home, 48 hours prior to attending Wetherby Racecourse.

Within the LFT kit, there are clear instructions on how to take the test and record the results, which can be done by visiting the website [HERE](#) or calling 119 (open between 7am and 11pm daily).

It is imperative that attendees DO NOT bring their physical test with them but record the LFT result with the NHS.

When the result has been recorded, you will receive a text message and email from the NHS, which you must bring with you to show on entry. This is deemed as a valid NHS COVID pass.

Please note that Wetherby Racecourse will not have LFT Kits available on the day of racing.

In accordance with government regulations, we will be unable to admit anyone who cannot provide the required Covid Pass documentation on the day, and in this occurrence no refunds will be applicable. Please ensure that you and everyone in your party is fully aware of the regulations in place.



FOR THE LOVE OF RACING

Please be prepared to show your Covid Certification. This is done via the NHS app (or paper version) and requires you to be fully vaccinated or show a negative PCR/Lateral Flow test within 48 hours of racing
