Saturday 26th Dec -£70.50 (includes £0.50 booking fee)

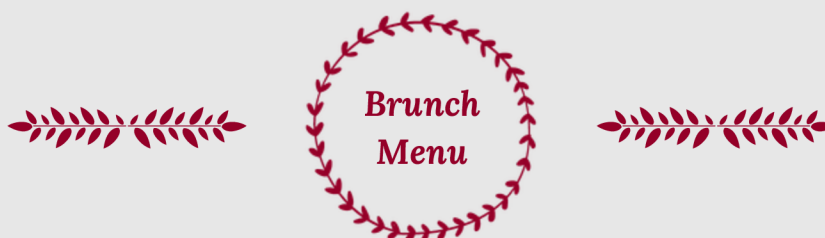
Sunday 27th Dec -£70.50 (includes £0.50 booking fee)

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The 1891 Bar

As a Premier Plus badge holder you are entitled to exclusive access to the 1891 bar up until the start of the second race when it will be open to all Premier racegoers. We advise that you plan your day to make the most of this facility and aim to arrive as early as you can. The suite is open from the time that gates open, and we suggest you check the [BHA website](#) for the most up to date information the evening prior to racing. Your Premier Plus badge also enables you to access our other Premier and Paddock Enclosure facilities through the day.

Seating

The 1891 bar offers a selection of informal and occasional style seating, and there is more than enough seating for the number of racegoers attending. The Premier Plus package does not include any form of 'reserved-seating' and the seating available is offered on a first-come basis. Smaller parties may be required to share a table with others. Whilst we are happy for parties to move chairs if necessary, we must insist for health & safety reasons that racegoers do not attempt to move tables.

Children & Elderly Guests

We offer a range of concessionary ticket prices to make our events more accessible. Concession rates are available for visitors aged 66 and over, as well as children aged 0-17 years. Full details of our ticket prices, eligibility, and any applicable terms and conditions can be found on our website.

Accessibility

If you or any member of your party has a disability or has any mobility issues which may make being seated on a high-level chair difficult then please contact us in advance and we can reserve lower-level seating for you.

Food & Drink

Your vouchers may only be redeemed within the 1891 bar on the date specified and your bistro voucher must be redeemed prior to the start of the first race. If you have special dietary requirements please notify us at least 48hrs in advance of the raceday. We regret that we cannot guarantee to meet dietary requirements without prior notification. You may take drinks in glassware out onto the 1891 balcony initially, however at the 2nd race Stewards may restrict the movement of glassware outside for Health & Safety reasons. Alternative plastic drinkware can be requested at the bar.

Race Programme - A race programme (or a racecard as they are often called) will be handed to you on entry to the suite on the day.

Dress Code

We do not operate a formal dress code at Wetherby. Smart casual attire is suggested and we also advise that you dress for the weather.

Smoking

Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is prohibited within all of our buildings and is also not allowed on the balcony of the 1891 suite.
